

MOORE COUNTY WILDLIFE AND CONSERVATION CLUB, INC.
POLICY STATEMENT FOR ADMINISTRATION OF CLUB SPONSORED MATCHES
ADOPTED JANUARY 13, 2025

The Moore County Wildlife and Conservation Club (“MCWCC” or “Club”), by action of its Officers and Board, hereby establishes effective January 13, 2025, this policy.

In the furtherance of our objective of promoting the exercise of the 2nd Amendment, the Club shall sponsor periodic match events, derived from NRA and other nationally recognized shooting challenges, and designed to allow the participants to practice and demonstrate their skills in a group setting. Such activities are commonly referred to as our **Club’s Match Events (“CME”)**.

To provide administrative guidance in conducting the CME, the following shall apply:

ORGANIZATION

1. Any Member in good standing may request to run a CME for the benefit of the Club. This request must contain a detailed Course of Fire description including an Emergency Action Plan (“EAP”) (see attached exhibit) and be submitted to the Club’s CRSO(s) for approval. All CMEs require preapproval either by a Club Chief Range Safety Officer (“CRSO”), or by Board vote, before the event can be scheduled.
2. Only qualified (having the skills and knowledge needed) Club Members will be permitted to run a CME. A Club CRSO is authorized to assess the qualifications of the Member seeking to run a CME as part of the approval process.
3. The proposed CME must also include a recommendation for the intended ratio of RSOs to Shooters. The CRSO shall have final authority to set a minimum number of RSOs needed to support the event.
4. For the purpose of setting the division of responsibilities, the Member running the CME shall be designated as the event’s Match Director (“MD”) and shall be responsible for (1) instructing participants in the Course of Fire, (2) arranging for a sufficient number of Range Safety Officers (“RSO(s)”) to provide oversight, and (3) directing activities (including setup and cleanup) on the day of the event itself. The MD shall determine what type of firearms and calibers shall be permitted, as well as the location of each firing position. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the RSO(s) will retain final authority in all safety-related matters.

SCHEDULING

1. The Club Board may appoint a responsible party to organize a calendar event schedule with the objective of offering no less than 12 CMEs spread over a 12-month period. The event schedule, once finalized, should be published so that it is accessible to the membership. (See attached exhibit)

SCHEDULING (continued)

2. An upcoming CME should be communicated using a minimum of two media (e.g., Website, Club Posting, Club Meeting Announcement, Email Campaign, etc.); the MD is authorized to request the timing and nature of communication.
3. The MD may elect to reschedule a CME to resolve a conflict, avoid unfavorable weather or at the request of an RSO in the event of an unsafe condition that cannot be satisfactorily mitigated.
4. Unless otherwise specifically restricted by the MD as part of the CME description, participation in all CMEs is assumed to be open to both members and guests. Participants shall be encouraged to pre-register via the website (see attached exhibit). Guests wishing to participate without a host member being present at the event are expected to pre-register to obtain access to the property. All guests must complete the Guest Waiver when entering the property.

BUDGETARY CONSIDERATIONS

1. Offering Club Match Events is designed to fulfill one of the core objectives for the Moore County Wildlife and Conservation Club. Accordingly, the Participation Fees and any related charges are intended to cover costs (both direct and indirect expenses) without generating profit.
2. To encourage participation in each CME the Club will offer, via a raffle covering all Participants, having as a prize a gift card in an amount set by the Club's Board. (At the drafting of this document, such amount is \$25.)
3. To encourage member participation as an MD, the Club will offer each MD, following their CME, a gift card in an amount set by the Club's Board. (At the drafting of this document, such amount is \$25.)
4. Subject to periodic adjustments by the Board, the following ancillary fees shall be assessed for those participating in each CME:

Club Members	\$5 /Shooter
Guests	\$20 /Shooter

Exceptions

18 years of age or younger – No Charge

Member who participates in MCWCC RSO Program – No Charge
