STEEL CHALLENGE CLINIC AND MATCH PRESENTED BY SPECIAL FORCES ASSOCIATION CHAPTER 6

Hello all,

Did you ever want to try competitive shooting? Shooting against others on the clock to see how your skills stack up, on demand, short of a gun fight?

Well here is your chance. Special Forces Association Chapter 6 (Camp Mackall) is running a Steel Challenge Clinic and Match on 18 May 2025 at the Gryphon Group ranges in Maxton, NC.

The idea is to run a 3 hour clinic for shooters who are interested in checking out what Steel Challenge competition shooting is all about, have lunch, then conduct a 6 stage Steel Challenge match in the afternoon for you to test your skills. We are doing this thru SCSA Steel Challenge. We will introduce you to the rules, the commands to follow w/ dos and don'ts and plenty of no stress practice with the guns involved. This is not a beginner shooting class. We will be giving tips on how to improve your gun handling and shooting skills for Steel Challenge and gladly give pro tips on the stages themselves.

We will provide instruction and even guns to try in all categories authorized in Steel Challenge. Be advised, this is a pistol caliber event from .22 LR to .45 ACP. Center fire pistols with or without red dot optics, pistol caliber carbines (PCC) and .22 rimfire pistols and rifles are OK. We will be shooting steel targets at close range.

If you want to participate and are not new to Steel Challenge, we will have stages and ROs available so you can use the morning to practice and get pro tips to improve your stage times for the afternoon match.

In other words it's for anybody who wants to spend the day shooting fast, on steel and competing. Please join us even if you participate in other shooting competitions.

Your instructor is Rick Turcotte, a retired Special Forces soldier and current Grand Master classified shooter in Steel Challenge. Several other classified shooters and SCSA Range Officers will serve as AIs.

Cost and Cause: A \$50 donation to SFA Chapter 6 in order to raise funds (100%) for the Memorial Valor Foundation supporting the Gold Star families of our Special Operations soldiers whom have died in service to our country. Information about this can be found at memorialvalor.com

Who: Anybody that loves to shoot and wants to learn about or participate in a Steel Challenge event.

What to bring: Bring a serviceable hand gun or PCC or rimfire rifle and enough mags to hold min 30rnds. Bring 300rnds of ammo for each gun you wish to shoot. If you want to shoot our guns you may, but you must buy whatever ammo you shoot (9mm & .22 LR available for purchase on site). If you're going to shoot center fire pistol you must have a holster. A rimfire pistol only needs to be in a case. Of course, hearing and eye protection is a must. We will provide lunch.

When: 0900- 1700, 18 May 2025

Where: Gryphon Group, 16780, Airbase Rd, Maxton NC, 28364, behind the HQs building. Signage will guide you to the right spot.
