

## **Dick Tracy Match**

(Tyro Course rules) – This course will be divided into three stages: all firing will be at 10 yards, **24 shots** 3 targets at each stage.

Target: NRA AP-1. Score: 240 possible points and 24 X's.

**Costumes (good or bad guy) are encouraged, and the individual voted by the match participants to have the best costume will have her/his aggregate score multiplied by a factor of 1.5 (for a possible score of 360 and 24 X's), AFTER the match scorer ranks shooters by raw score, as adjusted by the 5 shot revolver correction factor (see Note2 below).**

**Stage One:** 6 rounds total shot over 3 strings (1 string per target); 2 shots each string in 5 seconds on 1 of the 3 targets.

**Stage Two:** 6 rounds total shot in 1 string; 6 shots in 8 seconds; 2 shots on each of the 3 targets.

**Stage Three:** 12 rounds total shot in 1 string (which includes a reload); 6 shots, reload, 6 shots in 20 seconds; 4 shots fired on each of 3 targets.

**HANDICAP:** Shooters of 5-shot revolvers will have their scores at stage (b) and stage (c) multiplied by 1.2.

**Notes:** Open to centerfire revolvers and single-stack pocket pistols with a maximum barrel length of three inches (e.g., snub nose) and open sights (no optics permitted).

Match scorer will rank shooters by raw score, as adjusted by the 5 shot revolver correction factor, BEFORE applying the "Best Costume" factor. (*In prior years the shooter with the highest raw score has finished in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, behind the shooter with the Best Costume.*)
