.22 LR Dewar Bench Rest Rifle Match

August 18, 2024

This match is designed to be a fun, informal match that tests each shooter's ability.

Match Procedures:

This match is scheduled to begin at **10:00am**.

Competitors should plan to arrive **before 9:45am** to check in and get targets and assigned firing points.

The Safety Brief will begin at 10:00am. ALL COMPETITORS MUST ATTEND THE SAFETY BRIEF.

For those needing extensive time to fire in/sight in their rifles, please do so sometime before 9:45am.

Entry Fee: \$5, with Juniors competing free

(All guests of a member must turn in a guest waiver to the Range Officer, and ANY Junior NOT on the Club Youth Rifle Team must turn in to the Range Officer a completed guest waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian)

Match Rules:

This is a timed event, using .22LR rifles only. Both target sets are fired from a bench, with the competitor seated at the bench. Iron sights or scopes are allowed. The front of the rifle may be supported by a flat sandbag or shooting bag, or a bipod. Specialized bench rest supports, commercial or homemade, are not allowed. The stock of the rifle must be in contact with the shoulder of the competitor, and cannot be supported by any means other than the shooter's non-firing hand.

Course of Fire:

50 Yard Course:

Target is the A 23/5 target.

Sighters: Competitors get a 5-minute time period to shoot unlimited sighters. Sighters will be shot at the top single bullseye only.

Record Fire: Record fire begins within two minutes of completion of sighters. Competitors get a 20-minute time period to shoot 20 record shots, 5 record shots at each of the four record bullseyes.

100 Yard Course:

Targets are three TQ-4 targets.

Place the targets on the 100 yard backers with one target on top for sighters, and the two record fire targets either side-by-side or one above the other, below the sighter target.

Sighters: Competitors get a 5-minute time period to shoot unlimited sighters. Sighters will be shot at the top bullseye only.

Record Fire: Record fire begins within two minutes of completion of sighters. Competitors get a 20-minute time period to shoot 20 record shots, 10 record shots at each of the two record bullseyes.

Penalties:

More than six shots at a 50 yard bullseye, more than 11 shots at a 100 yard bullseye, and more than 20 record shots total: Highest scoring shot on that bullseye discounted, and lowest scoring 20 shots count if over 20 record shots in total.

Tie Breaker:

1st—Total # X's. 2nd—# X's at 100 yards. 3rd—High Score at 100 yards.

Safety:

All MCWCC Club range safety rules are in effect. Be Safe, Have Fun, and Shoot Well!
