

Long Range Pistol Match:

Summary: Course of Fire: A 30 shot (possible to fire 50 shots, given the format of the "walk back stage") match fired from the bench (pistol may not touch the bench) at an SR target (10 shots) and at steel knock down targets (10 shots with 10 points for each knock down) at 100 yards, followed by a new 10-shot "walk back" stage fired offhand, with a 2-hand hold, beginning at 30 yards. Walk-back stage is single elimination in which a miss will result in an opportunity to shoot offhand with a one-hand hold and a miss after firing from the one-hand hold will result in an opportunity to shoot with the weak hand in a one-hand hold. A failure to knock down the target with any of the 3 opportunities will eliminate the shooter from firing more shots.

A 30 shot, 300-point match fired in three phases:

(1st phase) from a rest at an SR paper target (10 shots);

(2nd phase) at a reactive target (10 shots) at 100 yards;

(3rd phase) One Shot in a "Walk Back" format from standing, 2-handed unsupported at:

(Walk Back phase subject to the availability of suitable reactive targets, such as Larue Tactical reactive targets).

Open to all centerfire pistols with iron sights of more or less traditional design, but NOT short barreled rifles masquerading as pistols.
