It sounds like Mike is already planning to run the Dewar bench rest match in August. It sounds like someone also was planning to run a 4-position match at some point.

My thought was to run a condensed version (slow fire stages only) of the standard CMP Rimfire Sporter match. This is a 3-position (four if you count kneeling instead of sitting) match shot in 3 stages:

Sitters-unlimited shots in 5 minutes
10 shots in 10 minutes at 50 yards-Prone
10 shots in 10 minutes at 50 yards-Sitting/kneeling
10 shots in 10 minutes at 25 yards-Standing

A total of 30 rounds (plus any sighters) for a max score of 300

Slings are highly recommended for use during the prone and sitting stages. Not allowed for Standing.

We will dispense with the CMP rules regarding eligible rifles and sights. They are fairly restrictive and sometimes confusing. Any 22LR rifle of traditional design is fine.

Scoped rifles or open-sighted rifles are fine. If we get enough shooters, maybe we can have a scoped class and iron sights class.

This would be a good prep match for either the Dewar match or the 4-position match.

I'll need both the 50 yard and 25 yard ranges reserved, plus the shooting mats and a few spotting scopes and stands. I'll also need an assistant to help move people between ranges and to set up the 25 yard range while we are shooting on the 50 yard range.

Also, if possible, I'd like to use actual CMP Rimfire Sporter targets ([Civilian Marksmanship Program eStore \(thecmp.org\)](https://www.thecmp.org)). They are available from the CMP store. I would order them, but I'm not current on my paperwork with the CMP. If someone in the club is, we could use 2-3 packs of these. It's not a huge deal so long as we have enough suitable targets for everyone to use.
