Carbine Cup Match (Second Annual)

40 Round Match for M1 Carbines

While this match is designed for M1 Carbines, which will use SR-1 targets at all stages, participants may fire other WWII era service rifles with different, smaller targets for prone slow fire, prone rapid fire and sitting rapid fire stages.

Stage 1: Prone Slow Fire. 10 rounds fired in 5 minutes from prone at SR-1 target at 100 yards. Other WWII era service rifles will use the MR31 target at 100 yards for this stage.

Stage 2: Prone from Standing Rapid Fire: 10 rounds fired in 60 seconds with reload from prone at SR-1 target at 100 yards. Other WWII era service rifles will use the SR21 target at 100 yards for this stage. Shooters will start the 60 second period from a standing position and, on command, will get into a prone position and fire the match from prone. Shooters whose age or disability makes this stage impossible for them, may start in prone or, in the discretion of the RO, fire the match from an alternate position.

Stage 3: Sitting or Kneeling from Standing Rapid Fire: 10 rounds fired in 60 seconds with reload from either sitting or kneeling position at SR-1 target at 100 yards. Other WWII era service rifles will use the SR21 target at 100 yards for this stage. Shooters will start the 60 second period from a standing position and, on command, will get into a kneeling or sitting position and fire the match from that position. Shooters whose age or disability makes this stage impossible for them, may start in sitting or kneeling or, in the discretion of the RO, fire the match from an alternate position.

Stage 4: Offhand Slow Fire: 10 rounds fired in 10 minutes, single-loaded, from the offhand position at SR-1 target at 100 yards. Same for other WWII era service rifles.
